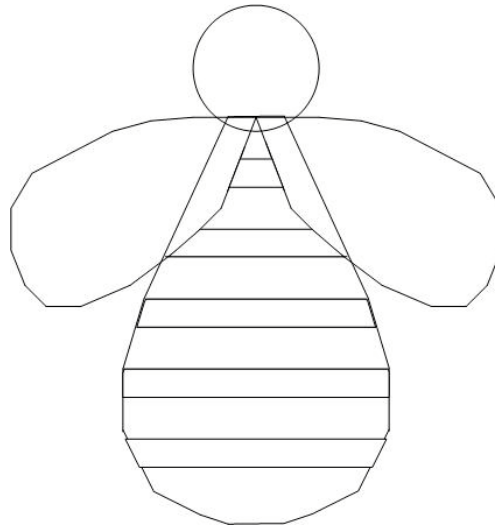


Appliqued Bee



Description:

This block is a friendly little bee. The stripes shown are optional.

This block will finish at 6" (6 ½" unfinished).

Wings may be made of a gauzy type of fabric to give a airy look to them.

Fabric Requirements:

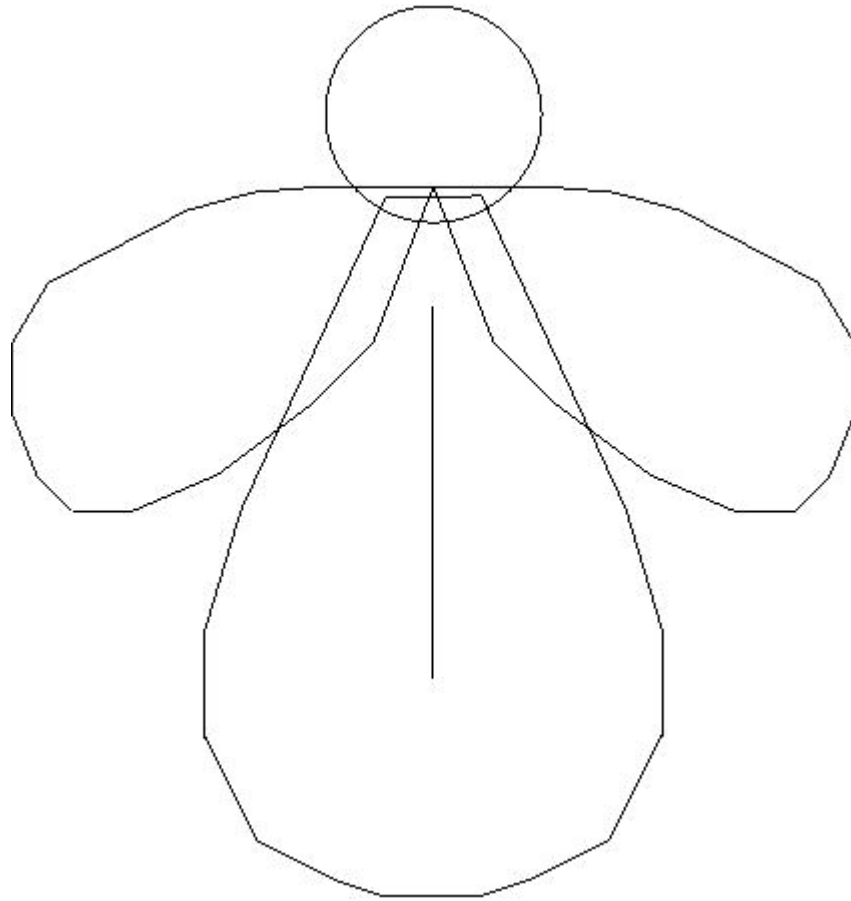
FABRICS	Yardage
Yellow (body of Bee)	4" square
Black (Stripes, head)	5" square
Grey (Wings)	5" square
Background	7" Square

Note: If antenna or a stinger is desired, then you will either need embroidery thread or machine embroidery thread in black for these.

Piecing:

1. Iron fusible webbing onto the wrong side of the fabrics for the bee. When everything has cooled down, trace the pattern pieces onto the paper side of the fusible. Remember to put the right side of the pattern pieces face down on the paper. This will mean that your pattern pieces will have the right orientation when you cut them out.
2. Pull the paper backing off, and arrange the sections on the background square. Press the sections to the background fabric.
3. Stitch around the sections using either a buttonhole or satin stitch.
