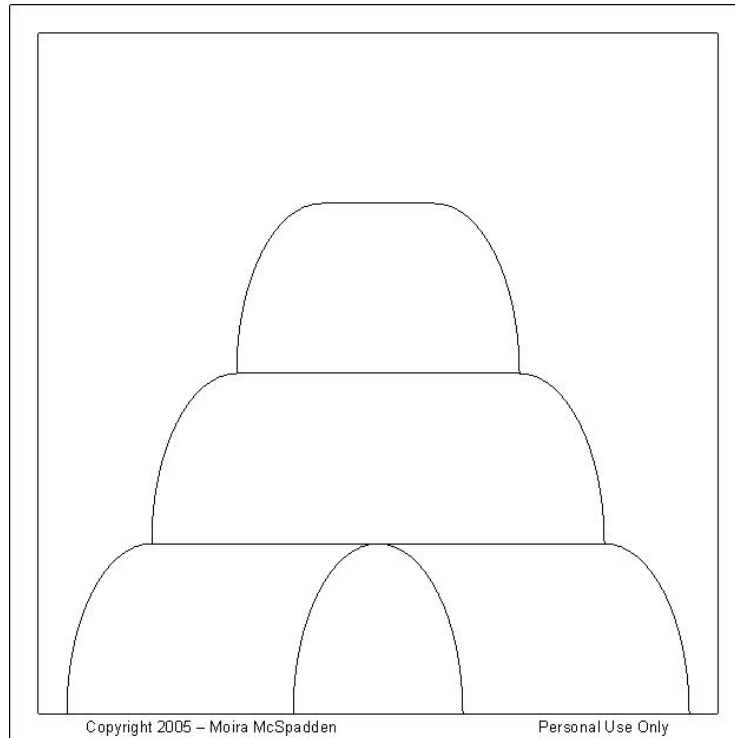


Appliqued Beehive block, 6" finished size



Fabric Placement:

Background Fabric	Background of block
Gold	Bottom, Middle, & Top sections of Hive
Black or Dark Brown	"Door" to hive

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric	Amount Needed
Background Fabric	6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square
Gold	7" square
Black or Dark Brown	4" by 4" piece

Section Assembly:

For each block wanted, cut one each of the top, middle, bottom sections of the hive and one door section. If machine appliquéing then fuse the sections down before stitching the block. Finished block should look like the picture above.

Sections:

If making block by machine appliqué, cut section on the outer line. Add seam allowance as needed to the bottom of the top and middle sections to enable them to tuck under the next section.

If making block by hand appliqué, then add $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to all edges of the three sections.
