

Stacked Stars

Description:

This block has 2 friendship stars "stacked" in the block giving a sense of depth to the block.

The block finishes at 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Fabric Required -

Background

Color 1 - for the larger star

Color 2 - for the smaller star

Fabric Placement:

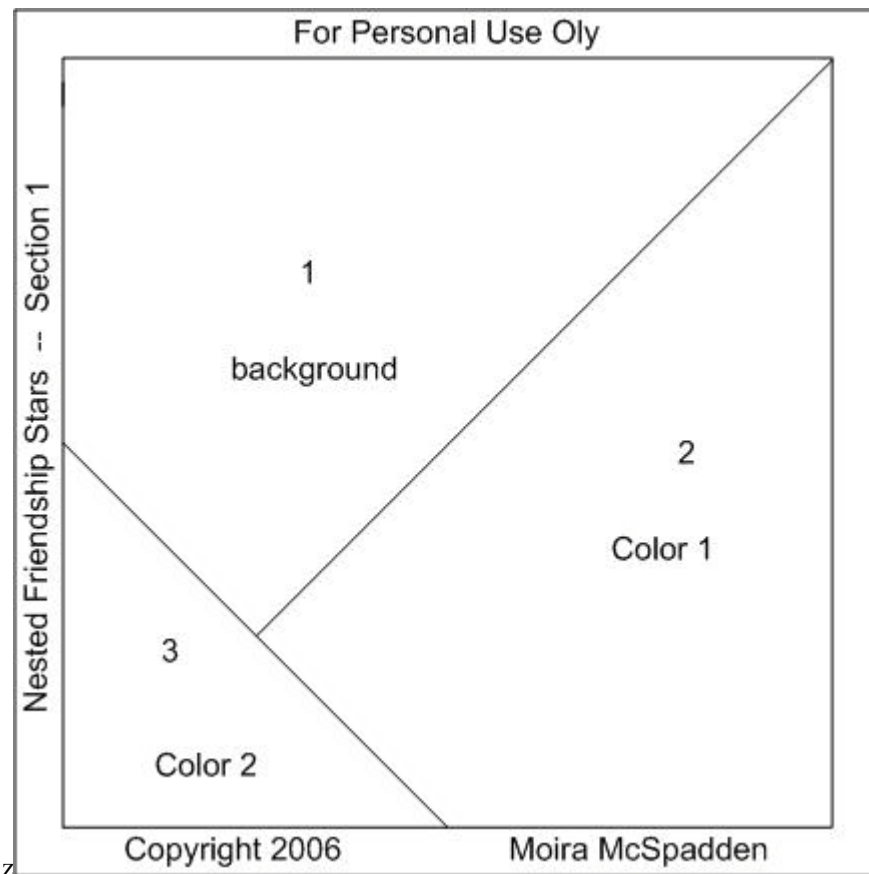
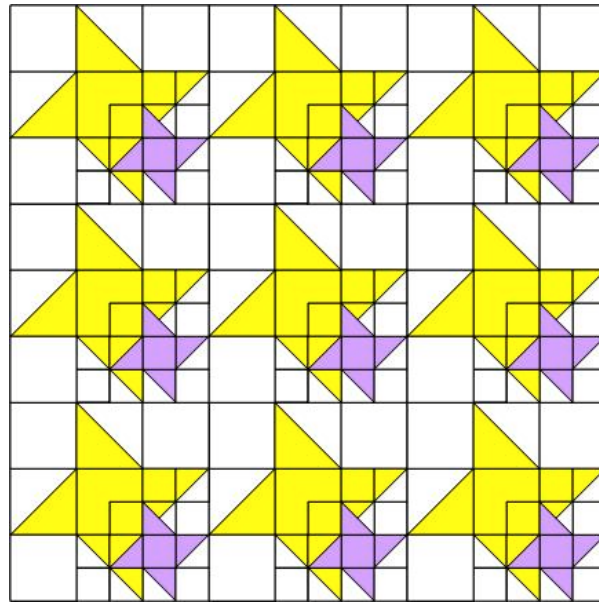
Color placement for the paper pieced sections is on the pattern pieces.

Piecing:

1. Make 1 copy of each of the 2 sections of the paper-pieced pattern pieces for each block that you want to make.
2. Make 2 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " half-squares blocks from Color 1 and your background for each block you make. Press and set aside.
3. Make 2 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " half-squares blocks from Color 2 and your background for each block you make. Press and set aside.
4. Cut the following 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares - 3 from your background fabric, 1 from Color 1 for each block you make.
5. Cut the following 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares - 1 from Color 2 and 1 from your background fabric for each block that you make.
6. Complete the two paper-pieced sections. Press and trim to size.
7. Sew sections together in rows. Sew rows together. Then remove the paper from the block sections. Press Flat.

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An example layout is shown below -



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
