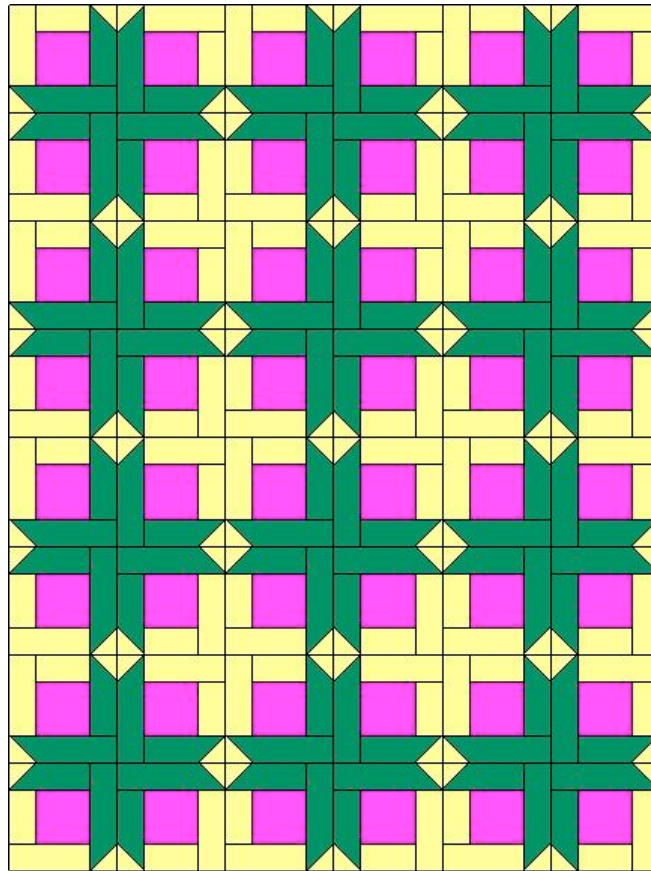


Woven Star Lap Quilt



Description:

This lap quilt features the use of a simple paper-pieced block, that when put together will have a 3D effect to it.

Yardage will be sufficient to piece this quilt for pre-cutting before paper-piecing the blocks. Fabric for any desired borders is not included in the fabric requirements.

Fabric Requirements:

Focus Fabric (Shown in dark Green)	1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards
Coordinate 1 (shown in Yellow)	1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards
Background (shown in Fuchsia)	1 yard

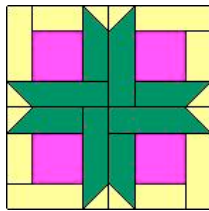
Pre-Cutting:

Background Fabric (Shown in Fuchsia)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 48 squares - 4" square
Focus Fabric (Shown in Dk.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 strips - 7" wide by width of fabric. Sub-cut these

Green)	<p>into a total of 48 strips that are 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" wide</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 strips - 6" wide by width of fabric. Sub-cut these into a total of 48 strips that are 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" wide.
Coordinate 1 (shown in Yellow)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 strips - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" wide by width of fabric. Sub-cut these into 48 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally once for a total of 96 triangles • 3 strips - 4" wide by width of fabric. Sub-cut these into 48 strips that are 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" wide. • 3 strips - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$" wide by width of fabric. Sub-cut these into 48 strips that are 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" wide.

Piecing:

1. Print 48 copies of the paper-pieced block pattern. Each copy will be 1/4th of a finished 12" block.
2. Using the fabrics that have been precut, sew your sections. Be sure to trim your seams to $\frac{1}{4}$ " as you sew. Press the blocks after completing them. Do not remove paper until after sewing the blocks together.
3. Sew 4 sections together to form one complete block. Be sure to turn each section 90 degrees so that the block looks like the picture below.



4. Complete the remaining 11 blocks for the lap quilt in the same manner.
5. Sew the blocks together in a 3 by 4 grid.
6. Add a border if desired.
7. Quilt and bind as desired.

Note: Be sure to use a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance when sewing the squares together.

An alternate color layout for the block and quilt is shown on the last page of this pattern.

Pattern should measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished.

For each finished block in your quilt, you will need to 4 copies of the patterns below.

Finished blocks should measure 12".
